



OUR ONGOING PROJECTS/PROGRAMS

HOLISTIC RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

SUPPORT, in collaboration with HDFC Bank, is implementing a three-year Holistic Rural Development Program (HRDP) in Chandwara block, Koderma district, Jharkhand. Focused on 15 villages, the program prioritizes Water Resource Development, Soil Erosion Prevention, Agriculture, Training, Capacity Building, Awareness Campaigns, Institutional Development, Animal Husbandry, and Infrastructure.

Its aim, from October 2021 to September 2024, is to empower around 3000 marginalized women farmers by creating sustainable livelihoods. It emphasizes Natural Resource Management techniques, encourages new agricultural practices, advocates health and sanitation, and fosters income opportunities for women and youth. Livestock management is also integrated to enhance income generation and socio economic development.



HOLISTIC RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME CASE STUDY

Adaptation of Model Agriculture Farming

In Bendi, an economically challenged rural area in Koderma district, agriculture stands as the primary income source for the lower socio-economic community. Hindered by poor soil quality and inadequate irrigation, crop production faced obstacles.

When informed about solar-based micro lift irrigation by HDFC Bank and SUPPORT during a village committee meeting, over 20 households eagerly embraced the system near the community pond.

After a feasibility assessment, a 5 HP Solar micro lift irrigation was installed with an underground pipeline, irrigating over 50 acres. With best crop practices, a production cluster emerged, benefiting 25 families. Ram Kisun Ageri, a local farmer, noted the transformation—previously hindered by irrigation limitations, now thriving alongside 20-25 other farmers due to the solar-based system facilitated by HDFC Bank and SUPPORT.



TRANSFORMATION OF ANGANWADI CENTER

Early childhood care and education profoundly have children's mental and psychological development. HDFC and SUPPORT, within the HRDP program, prioritized Anganwadi renovation, including modular furniture, vibrant Bala painting, toys, and Kent water filter installation.

This transformation empowered ANMs and Ashas, enhancing their efficiency.

Post-HRDP intervention, enrollment and attendance notably surged.

Emphasizing moral values and health hygiene, regular awareness sessions are conducted, nurturing these traits from a young age. Babita Devi, an Anganwadi sevika, lauds the remarkable support of SUPPORT and HDFC in creating an exemplary center.

The provision of these facilities brought immense joy to children, fostering improved enrollment and attendance while creating a conducive learning environment.

Mega Watershed Program JIWI DA HASA



This initiative rejuvenates ecosystems and livelihoods in marginalized areas of Jharkhand by empowering Gram Panchayats to effectively use MGNREGA for watershed-based rejuvenation.

It aims to double incomes, enhance production, and restore ecology by merging wage entitlements with other schemes. Strengthening community and Gram Panchayat capabilities boosts climate resilience and fosters economic growth. The core strategy leverages MGNREGA, Jharkhand Government programs, and local resources for sustainable development

“ In the blocks of Jagannathpur and Noamundi of West Singhbhum district, Jharkhand, the project is implemented to foresee a self-sustainable effective and empowered mahila mate forum comprising of 300 mahila mates who are able to take decision both collectively and individually and providing safe public spaces towards gender equality, respect and recognition ”

OUTPUT OF MATE CAPACITY BUILDING

- 150 women mates start working on the field
- Mates are now capable of checking the payment of wages and material, mate payment from the portal and also it has been seen a common understanding among themselves.
- Awareness about MGNREGA among women mates.
- Learned to measure, calculate and filled Muster roll.
- Violence on women workers at work place has decreased.
- They are now capable to check their panchayat ongoing schemes and expenditure from MGNREGA site.
- They are looking capable of looking at the number of job card holders in the panchayat and the work done by them from their job cards, based on the payment of the work they are preparing the work strategy.
- Women mates provide safe environment to women workers.
- Women mates have brought positive response for women workers.

Mega Watershed Program JIWI DA HASA (CASE STUDY)

Case study of Chandmani Sinku - Journey from labour to president of women mate forum

● **Family Background:**

Chandmani Sinku 24 years lives in village Patajaint which comes under Jagannathpur Block, West Singhbhum district of Jharkhand State. As usual like a typical poor village family her husband is a migrant labour who works in Chennai. Earlier this family used to live under a joint family but due to some family issues her family got separated. Now Chandmani Sinku has the sole responsibility of her own. She earns her livelihood working as a labour in MGNREGA.



● **Point of intervention/ Role of Community Mobiliser**

During the training program organized by SUPPORT Led by CRP Mrs Shanti Pinguwa, she got the information about various government schemes under MGNREGA. She asked the community mobiliser that she wanted to take benefit of MGNREGA schemes, but she did not know anything about it. She wanted to come out of her poor economic condition to sustain her family expenses. Mrs Shanti Pinguwa suggested her to apply for the MGNREGA mate; with this she can earn some income at her village. During Gram Sabha held by our SUPPORT CRP Mrs Shanti Pinguwa at her village she was nominated and she got selected as a mate of her village.

She agreed for the same and attended the fresher's mate training organized by SUPPORT at Block Office Jagannathpur.

Under the 3 days' mate training, on 1st day she got knowledge about MGNREGA. On 2nd day of training she knew about mate qualification, role and responsibility of mate, payment details of semi-, skilled labour.

On 3rd day of training, she learned how to lay out in the field and ultimately, she got registered in MGNREGA mates.

Now currently she is working as a mate. Under the MGNREGA Chandmani Sinku has working actively in different schemes like Didi badi Yojana, Bagwani, Medhbandi, Dobha talab etc. and uplifting various needy village people. At block level Mate Forum meeting held by SUPPORT Team all the block level Mates were invited, she got nominated as Mate Forum President.

● **Present situation/changes/impact:**

Seeing her good and active work as women mate she was awarded with "Prasatipatra" from BDO madam Chaibasa, at district level women mate Sammelan. Chandmani sinku is now very happy with her work as she has achieved what she dreamt and selected as president in mate forum. She gives her heartfelt thanks to the SUPPORT staffs, with the help of which she is now living a prestigious and dignified life.



Case Study

A New Hope with Nutrition Garden

Being a part of a poor family, the family used to struggle a lot to meet their fundamental necessary, the family having 2.5 acre of land for cultivation which was not sufficient source of income, in the same time the education of their children hampered they perceived. They wanted to overcome from this circumstances although they had no other option with them, apart from them due to lack of knowledge on different vegetables cultivation they used to depend on mono crop (Potato) cultivation in Rabi season. Which used to lead to a health hazard situation among family members they often faced different sickness. Intervention in the year 2023 the SUPPORT came to the village is blessing in disguise with different proto type, in the very beginning part of the program with concept of multilayer vegetables crop cultivation promoted in their village SHG, Smt. Rani Devi attend few on field training programs. Smt. Rani Devi decided to start nutrition garden in her back yard in 4 dismal of land. Transformation She started selling of vegetables product in local markets @ Rs. 40/kg and earned 11,000/- till date. Apart from self-consumption. She has shared her experience when they faced financial problem now they are having a bit of stress-free life. Conclusion Smt. Rani Devi, and her husband says that, it was really a life transformation substance when they got village level training for doing the Back yard kitchen garden and cultivation of different vegetables in a small level of land.

WATERSHED DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM


SUPPORT, under NABARD's Watershed Development Fund, is executing initiatives in Petarbar, Bokaro. Focusing on rainwater harvesting, groundwater recharge, and soil erosion mitigation through LBS, Nala Bund, and Farm Bunding, the project addresses migration, promotes wage employment, and improves rural living standards.

It aims to elevate agricultural productivity, conserve sources, facilitate climate change adaptation, and capacitate stakeholders for rehabilitation, emphasizing quality structures, expanding agricultural land, and fostering community ownership for socio-economic upliftment.

CASE STUDY



A success story of Koh Jalchajan-Peterwar

1. Project Name: - Koh Jalchajan,
2. Location: - Petarwar, Bokaro
3. Received financial assistance: - NABARD (W.D.F.)
4. Technical assistance - SUPPORT Organization
5. Start of work – CBP (Capacity Building Phase): - JAN-2018 to AUG-2019.
6. FIP (Full Implementation Phase):- AUG-2020 to 2025.

This is the story of a farmer under Koh Jalchajan, who earlier, due to lack of water, used to cultivate only 3 acres of paddy and 1-1.5 acres of rainfed vegetables out of his 10 acres of land and that too only for food and for a few months. They used to live in the same village and then after finishing farming, they used to go outside to earn.

So we are talking about a farmer from Koh, whose name is Manoj Murmu, father late. Narsingh Manjhi, whose field has been strengthened by NABARD watershed and two dobhas, one 50*50*10 and one 80*60*10, have been made next to his fields and due to this, today he can grow Kerala, Cucumber, Bottle gourd, Tomato in his land, are cultivating brinjal, okra, corn and almonds in about 6 acres of land and are cultivating paddy in 3 acres of land, due to which their annual income is around Rs 2.5 lakh. From that income, 4 acres of land is used for drip irrigation. Where they could barely get one farm a year, now they do farming all year round.

Today he is teaching his children in a good school. He says that if a program like Watershed had come earlier, we would have been able to educate and feed our elder children well. Today, he also helps the people of the village financially. Apart from this, today they are doing farming by taking neighboring villages and neighboring fields on lease and are earning good income. Today, they transport their produce by auto to Petarwar and sometimes to the markets of Bokaro. Along with this, he is also doing fish farming from the pond. Today he does not go outside to earn money, rather he works in farming and watershed project work in the village itself and spends his life happily.

TDF WADI PROJECT



Building on Tribal Development Program, NABARD launched a nationwide initiative to replicate small orchards (1-2 acres) through the Tribal Development Fund (TDF), NABARD in collaboration with SUPPORT implemented a tribal development program for enhancing livelihoods through small orchards and integrating non-orchard activities like animal husbandry, sericulture, and NTFP for landless tribal families. The objective of this fund is to create replicable models of integrated development of tribal families on a participatory basis, through the adoption of sustainable income generating activities and to build a strengthen tribal institutions which enable mainstreaming of the communities by improving their socio-economic status.

RAISING SEMIALATA PLANTATIONS FOR LAC CULTIVATION

In FY2022, NABARD approved two projects in Jharkhand under its Tribal Development Fund (TDF) to establish semialata plantations on half-acre plots for lac insect cultivation. These projects aim to provide immediate livelihood opportunities to 1,000 tribal families while also benefiting landless communities.

Unlike traditional farming, lac cultivation offers a sustainable, forest based livelihood that leverages the indigenous knowledge of tribal populations. Over the anticipated 4-5-year project period, the initiative seeks to strengthen the lac value chain, promote processing and value addition, enhance market access (including exports), and reduce farmers' dependence on exploitative middlemen.

The initial funding covers plantation setup, related costs, and operational expenses for two years. This is complemented by a three year grant and five years of technical support from the Indian Institute of Natural Resins and Gum (IINRG) in Ranchi.

The projects are being implemented by SUPPORT in the Churchu and Dari blocks of Hazaribagh District.




Project Area: Churchu & Dari Blocks in Hazaribagh District, Jharkhand






OUTCOMES REACHED TDF WADI - II


To enhance the livelihoods of vulnerable households in selected rural areas by leveraging locally available natural resources and developmental programs.

Smart Village Lakhpati kisaan Program



TATA Trusts, CInI, and SUPPORT uplift marginalized rural communities in India by enhancing quality of life, healthcare, and education. Their "Lakhpati Kisan" program, started in 2015, aims to uplift thousands of households through agricultural and non-agricultural activities, water conservation, and efficient post-harvest processes. They focus on strengthening farmer producer organizations and promoting sustainable agriculture, livelihoods, and healthcare in 16 Gram Panchayats and 58 villages in Churchu & Dadi.

CASE STUDY



This case study is based on the experience of a group of farmers who formed water users' group and decided to do high value agriculture to boost their income and to enhance their socio-economic condition.

The study also highlights the process of how did the farmers turned barren land into cultivable one by their collective efforts. Previous Milieu- Katulwatand WUG is consisted of 08 members who used to do traditional crops like paddy, wheat, potato, ground nuts, and some pulses before the installation of solar MLI system in their patch.

These farmers got demotivated while getting the results from their conventional techniques of agriculture. Most of the areas were occupied by bushes and couch-grasses, the stones were preventing the farmers from optimizing the land for cultivation. Most of their members used to be dependent on daily wage labor work and in off seasons they used migrate inter and intra state. The condition of all of these households were merely dependent on daily wage and to a very minor extent from agriculture. Since the farmers used to cultivate paddy, they were only able to secure their round the year food consumption but they never sold anything due to less production. It was a very suffering situation for the farmers at that time when they wanted to do high value crop cultivation but due to minimum resources and awareness, they were unable to satisfy their wishes.

Present Condition- In the year 2021 the program intervened in this village called Rikwa and subsequently it has started its activities in this village. At first officials of SUPPORT and CInI, Tata Trusts conducted a series of awareness generation trainings to inculcate the concept of Samajhdar Lakhpati Kisan. After scouting the water resources in Upartola hamlet in the village this patch of Katulwatand came into light and with the support of villagers the solar MLI installed in the year 2022. Before its installation these 8 members started tomato cultivation on 1 acre, brinjal on 40 decimals, chilli on 10 decimals in Rabi season and for this intervention all of them had to ensure the land leveling of the patch. Since it was the first time from Tata Trusts Annual Narrative Report 1 st April to 31 st March them hence the output was not satisfactory but it boosted the confidence of the farmers to improve and overcome the challenges. When the solar MLI system successfully installed in their patch they decided to cultivate tomato on 2.5 acres, brinjal on 50 decimals, chili on 20 decimals and mixed crops on 1 acre in summer season. After earning a handsome amount from it they installed drip irrigation system on their patch, a net house for protective farming, and a concrete trellis for creeper cultivation. In this year they cultivated cucumber on 3 acres with drip and mulch. It gave them Rs. 100000 in return. The farmers also cultivated bitter gourd from the trellis which gave them Rs.6000 in return and Rs.8500 from capsicum from the net house. At present this water users group made a plan to cultivate on 5 acres of tomato, 1 acre of cauliflower, 60 decimal brinjal, 40 decimal chilli, and coriander in the net house as well as Bitter gourd on its 10 decimal which can hopefully give them a high income. Apart from the engagements of farmers in their own patch they are also planning to expand the right techniques of farming in their nearby agricultural lands where farmers had been facing challenges to receive the yield from high value crops. Such activities performed by farmers are aiming at the development of a model production cluster in the villages like Rikwa.

JHARKHAND JAL Chhajan Yojana (JJY)

The primary goals of the Jharkhand Jal Chhajan Yojana (JJY) are to enhance groundwater recharge, improve water resource management, and promote sustainable agricultural practices in rural areas of Jharkhand. By implementing various natural resource management techniques, such as the construction of ponds, check dams, and bunding systems, the project aims to increase the availability of water for irrigation and domestic use. Additionally, JJY seeks to empower local communities through training programs that focus on livelihood enhancement, agricultural productivity, and water conservation practices. Ultimately, the initiative aspires to create resilient rural communities that can effectively manage their water resources, ensuring long-term sustainability and improved quality of life for the residents of Jharkhand.
